Adder Technology Ltd. Statement regarding the use of Conflict Minerals

“Conflict Minerals” refers to specific minerals originating from mines controlled by armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries such as Sudan, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Republic of Tanzania, Angola and the Central African Republic. The Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act Section 1502, and later the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 restrict the use of certain minerals from mines in these countries that are controlled by armed, non-government military groups or unlawful military factions.

Adder requires our suppliers to undertake reasonable due diligence within their supply chain to ensure that conflict minerals are not being sourced from mines in these conflict areas. We ask all our suppliers to source products that contain these minerals from recognized sources that can be traced back to the authorised smelters list, currently published by the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition Global Sustainability Initiative (EICC-GeSI).

The Restricted Minerals are:

Columbite-tantalite

Gold

Tin / Casserite

Tungsten

Adder designates its products conflict mineral free based upon information provided by our suppliers, and do not knowingly use these minerals or their by-products, as specified by the Conflict Minerals Trade Act.
